



The Toos Foundation sponsored a special program on the 29<sup>th</sup> of November in London which concentrated on the history of classical music, ballet, and opera in Iran. In this program, there were famous musical artists such as Dehlavi and Baghcheban present.

Nikzad and Mrs. Elizabeth Mansfield. The host of the program on this occasion was Miss. Jamileh Kharrazi who spoke about the history of the classical music in Iran and the
